TATTOOING

Extent of Byelaws

These byelaws shall extend to the Borough of Crawley

Interpretation:

1. (a) In these byelaws unless the context otherwise requires:

be changed at least once every working day or more frequently as necessary and shall be sealed prior to disposal;

- (e) All needles intended for disposal are placed in disposable needle boxes designed for the purpose. The boxes shall be disposed of safely. All needles intended for re-use shall be placed in leakproof and washable containers capable of being sterilised. The containers shall be emptied at least once every working day or more frequently as necessary, and the needles and containers sterilised for re-use;
- (f) All furniture and fittings in the premises are kept clean and in such good repair as to enable them to be cleaned effectively;
- (g) All tables, couches and seats used by clients in the treatment area, and any surface on which the items specified in byelaw 3(b) are placed immediately prior to treatment, have a smooth impervious surface which is wiped down with a suitable disinfectant between the treatment of different clients and

as is appropriate, is sterile;

- (ii) Has not previously been used in connection with any other client unless it consists of a material which can be and has been cleaned and, so far as is appropriate, sterilised;

(b) An operator shall ensure that:-

- (i) any needle, metal instrument, or other item of equipment, used in treatment or for handling instruments and needles used in treatment, is in a sterile condition and kept sterile until it is used;

(ii) All dressings used for the treatment of wounds, cuts, abrasions, or other injuries, are sterile;

NOTE - THE FOLLOWING DOES NOT FORM PART OF THE BYELAWS

(A) Proprietors shall take all reasonable steps to ensure compliance with these byelaws by persons working on the premises. Section 16(9) of the Act lays down that a registered person shall cause to be prominently displayed on the premises a copy of these byelaws and a copy of any certificate of registration issued to him under Part VIII of the Act.
