Seek to vire funding between projects (Green Infrastructure Business Grants and Crawley Innovation Centre), on a local delegated basis.

Report on progress, finance, KPIs, RAG ratings and risks.





Pop Up Culture Events:

38 Events taken place to end Sept across 19 sites, comprising: 98 event days, 139 further days when work was on display, 5,135 people directly engaged (people actively taking part with a dwell time up to 2 hours).

1,063 flats cavity wall insulated.

87 employee collaborations at Crawley College.

50 new learners enrolled in courses.




